
DESTINATION OF THE MONTH

Why Jaipur is Pink?

Jaipur is known as the Pink City. Tourists coming here when they see all the buildings are pink they are surprised and ask why Jaipur was colored Pink. The main reason for the uniform color of Jaipur lies with Maharaja Sawai Ram Singh who want to host Prince Albert during his visit to India in 1876 in a royal way. It was an ideal opportunity for him to strengthen ties with the British aristocracy. He was such a great host that he constructed a lavish concert hall and named it Albert Hall in honor of the prince. Same time Maharaja also decided beautifying his city and this included repainting the entire city.

While they thought of repainting city in a unique way they decided to paint entire city in same color. After discussion they chose color was terracotta pink, this color historically represents welcoming and hospitality. As per order entire city was colored pink. Now question arises why Jaipur maintained its distinct pink color even after the visit by Prince Albert 140 years ago. The reply is Maharaja Sawai Ram Singh's favorite Maharani convinced him to pass a law making it illegal for buildings to be painted any other color than Jaipur Pink. This law passed in 1877 still remains effective. this is the reason why Jaipur got this color Pink.
